TOURNAMENT LOCATION:	Butte, Montana
TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR:	Ronald Rowling - District #4 Commissioner
TOURNAMENT SITES:	Butte: Longfellow 10U 2 fields, Father Sheehan 12U or 14U 3 fields, Stodden Park 16 U & 18U 3 lighted fields. Anaconda: Charlotte Yeoman Complex 12U or 14U 4 fields.
TOURNAMENT UMPIRE IN CHIEF:	To be determined
GATE ADMISSION:	None
STARTING TIMES:	Depending on Number of Teams – Friday morning.
TOURNAMENT ENTRY FEE:	All entrants must have \$325 and team tournament roster to their District Commissioner for signature by 10:00pm on Tuesday, July 5th.
COACH REQUIREMENTS:	Montana USA Softball rules and USA Softball national rules require that one coach is ACE certified and that all other adults who will be on the field or in the dugouts must have a background check and Safe Sport. It is recommended that more than one coach have ACE certification, if the one ACE certified coach is not able to be present.
TOURNAMENT DRAW:	The tournament draw will be in accordance with USA Softball and USA Softball of Montana rules. The draw will be conducted the Sunday or Monday preceding the tournament and posted to the State Softball web sites.
TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN:	Site to be determined. Starting 6:00 PM Thursday Night – Friday morning
AWARDS:	Team Trophies - 1st, 2nd and 3rd depending on number of teams and 1st and 2nd individual awards for each division depending on number of teams.

CAMPING

Absolutely no camp trailers or motorhomes of any type in Stodden Park.

Butte:

- 1.) Longfellow: there is limited space here that is grass behind the outfield fence of the Helen Austin Field, please no camping on the grass in the playground area.
- 2.) Father Sheehan: This has limited grass areas between the fields as most of the other areas are for parking, please no camp trailers or motorhomes south of the concession stand area.
- 3.) Copper Mountain Park: camping allowed on the west and south end parking lots. Please do not camp in the parking lots nearest the legion baseball field.
- 4.) Butte Plaza Mall: I am working on making arrangements to camp behind the mall.

Anaconda:

No camping at WASHOE Park as Art in the Park is being held the same weekend.
